

VILLAGE OF CAPE VINCENT BOARD OF TRUSTEES NOV. 25, 2008

Mayor Timothy D. Maloney opened the meeting at 5:30 PM with Trustees Robert Doud, Alan Ada, and Joseph Gould present. Trustee Douglas Putnam was absent.

Trustee Ada would like the Nov. 12, 2008 meeting minutes corrected to state he corrected the previous meeting minutes and Trustee Doud asked the word violations be changed to complaints pertaining to the Landers situation. With these changes Trustee Doud made the motion to accept the minutes with Trustee Gould seconding the motion and all voting yes.

Trustee Gould made the motion to hold the Village organizational meeting on December 9, 2008 at 5:15 PM with Trustee Doud seconding the motion and all voting yes.

The Clerk reported the Village has advertised for the vacant position on the Zoning Board of Appeals with a deadline for applications December 8th.

Trustee Doud asked if the data for the informational meeting would include the Village financial obligation. Mayor Maloney responded the information should be available and commented the Village water rates would be much higher to the Village consumer if the Town and Development Authority did not purchase water.

A short discussion was held on the lease expiring for Horne Transportation on January 1, 2009. Trustee Doud made the motion to review square foot charges in this area for rental buildings, which are comparable to the Village Law Building. Trustee Ada seconded the motion with all voting yes. Mayor Maloney appointed Trustee Doud to research this matter.

Mayor Maloney read correspondence from the NYS Department of Transportation detailing they have concluded their evaluation of restrictive parking in front of the Broadway Pizzeria and handicap parking to be added in front of the Roxy Hotel. The necessary signs have been installed but the pavement has not been marked to indicate these changes. Trustee Ada will check with the officer in charge to see if signage is enforceable without pavement markings.

Village Officials have had correspondence with representative of the NYS Health Department advising them funding may become available for wastewater projects in the near future.

Trustee Ada made the motion to adjourn at 6:05 PM with Trustee Gould seconding the motion and all voting yes.
